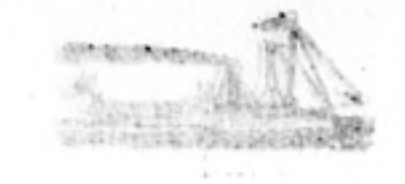

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

Y. whereof Samuel Wood is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1857, as appears by the Certificate of Vincent Bidwell Shipwright her builder on file in this office

And R. H. Post Surveyor appointed to measure said Schooner having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 143 feet 5 inches her breadth 30 feet 5 inches her depth 11 feet 11 1/4 inches and that she measures 478 tons 38 and that she is a Schooner has a square ninety-fifths stern head.

And the said H. C. Walker and head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
