In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

H. C. Walker
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo and is President of The Lake Navigation Company, a Corporation organized under the laws of the State of New York, located at Buffalo, and the said Company is the

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Trig Propeller called the Levathan of Buffalo whereof James M. Averill is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo New York in the year 1857, as appears by the certificate of B. B. Jones, Shipwright, her builder on file in this office -

And R. H. Best Surveyor approued to measure said Trig, having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has one deck and one mast and that her length is 125 feet 2 inches her breadth 26 feet 1 inches her depth 10 feet 6 inches and that she measures 315 tons 64 ninety-fifths that she is a Trig Propeller has a round stern and a plain head.

And the said H. C. Walker having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
