In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

Abram VanNorman
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek and owns 1/2 part undivided of the Schooner Chief Justice Marshall of Buffalo; and that George R. Hibbe and Edwin S. Shaw both of said Buffalo and each own 1/4th part undivided of said Schooner

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the said Schooner Chief Justice Marshall of Buffalo whereof said VanNorman is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cape Vincent State of New York in the year 1843, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port April 28, 1854. No. 49 now surrendered having changed owners

And said Certificate having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 114 feet 6 inches her breadth 21 feet 6 inches her depth 8 feet 9 inches and that she measures 181 tons etc. ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern head.

And the said A. VanNorman and having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
