PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

Charles Ensign
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in the Dist. of Buffalo Creek, and owns 1/2 part undivided of the Propeller Pittsburgh of Buffalo; and Silas Merchant, and Charles Marsden both reside at Cleveland Ohio. and each own 1/4th part undivided of said Propeller and they all are Citizens of the United States, and sole owners of the said Propeller called the Pittsburgh of Buffalo N. Y. - whereof James P. Bickwith is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland Ohio in the year 1856, as appears by the certificate of her Enrollment dated at this Port March 31. 1857 - No. 22 now surrendered having changed owners

And said Certificate having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 186 2/10 feet inches her breadth 27 9/10 feet inches her depth 12 13/10 feet inches and that she measures 606 tons 10 - ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has a Square stern and a plain head.

And the said Chas. Ensign and a plain head. having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
