District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850

Rufus R. Johnson
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek and is managing owner of the *Trig Propeller* called the *Noah P. Sprague* of Buffalo and owns 1/3 part parts undivided of said Propeller and *James F. Snow* resides at said Buffalo and owns 1/3 part undivided of said Propeller and that they are both

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the *Trig Propeller* called the *Noah P. Sprague* of Buffalo whereof *James F. Snow* is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo New York in the year 1857, as appears by the certificate of J. N. Jones Shipwright her builder on file in this office

And *H. P. Clinton* Surveyor to measure said vessel having certified that the said *Trig Propeller* or Vessel has one deck and no mast and that her length is 198 feet 6 inches her breadth 21 feet inches her depth 9 feet 6 inches and that she measures 173 tons ninety-fifths that she is a *Trig Propeller* has a square round stern head.

And the said *Rufus R. Johnson* and *James F. Snow* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Propeller* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
