In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

David N. Tuttle
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo
in the District of Buffalo Creek and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner called the *Aerial*
of Buffalo, whereof he is a
at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Sackett Harbor* State of
New York in the year *1847*, as appears by the certificate of her last
Enrollment dated at this Port *October 6. 1856* No. *196*
now surrendered

And said Certificate
the said Schooner or Vessel has *one* deck and *two* masts and that
her length is *118* feet *4* inches
her breadth *24* feet *4* inches
her depth *9* feet *6* inches
and that she measures *252* tons *41* ninety-fifths
that she is a *Schooner* has a *Square* stern
and a *scroll figure* head.

And the said *D. N. Tuttle*
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with
the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the **Port of Buffalo, N. Y.**
