In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

Refus R Johnson  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo  
in the Dist. of Buffalo Creek and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner called the Carver  
is at present Master; and as he has sworn  
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo is a  
New York in the year 1857, as appears by the Certificate of his last State of  
Enrollment dated at this Port April 23. 1857 No. 26  
Now surrendered having changed owners.

And said Certificate  
the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that  
her length is 42 1/2 feet 3 inches  
her breadth 15 feet 10 inches  
her depth 10 feet 0 inches  
and that she measures 387 tons 49 ninety-fifths  
that she is a Schooner has a Square stern  
and Scull head.

And the said R. R. Johnson  
agreed to the description and measurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with  
the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
