In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo

Transportation Company, a corporation organized under the laws

~~Citizen~~ of the United States, and sole owner of the Canal boat called the
Towa of Buffalo whereof Stenberg
is at present Master; and as he has sworn
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo ^{is a}
New York in the year 1853, as appears by the Certificate of C. B. Tausky ^{State of}
the purport the build be on file in this office.

And the Surveyor of the Port of New York ^{having certified that}
the said Canal boat or Vessel has ^{one} deck and ^{two} masts and that
her length is 82 feet inches
her breadth 14 feet 9 inches
her depth 5 feet 6 inches
and that she measures 62 ^{tons} 13 ^{ninety-fifths}
that she is a Canal boat has a square stern/
round bow and no head.

agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with
