In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

Pearl S. Sternburg
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo Dist. of Buffalo Creek and is President of the Western Transportation Company, a Corporation organized under the laws of the State of New York, located at Tonawanda in said District; and that said Company

is the true
Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Canal boat called the
C. L. Wright of Buffalo whereof said Sternburg is at present Master; and as he has sworn
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1852, as appears by the Certificate of C. C. Vanslyke
Shipwright her builder on file in this office

And the Surveyor of the port of New York having certified that
the said Canalboat or Vessel has one deck and no mast and that
her length is 82 feet inches
her breadth 14 feet 9 inches
her depth 3 feet 6 inches
and that she measures 62 tons 1374 ninety-fifths
that she is a Canalboat has a square stern
round top and no head.

And the said P. S. Sternburg Master, having agreed to the description and admasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Canalboat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
