## District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

*Hiram Miles*  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo and is the President of the American Transportation Company a corporation organized under the laws of the State of New York located at Buffalo, and that said Company is the

~~Citizen of the United States~~, and sole owner of the Canal Boat called the *Oregon of Buffalo* whereof *John Pease* is at present Master; and as he has sworn ~~Citizen of the United States~~, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Buffalo* State of *New York* in the year 1857, as appears by the Certificate of *Peter Carroll* Shipwright under whose superintendance said Canal Boat was built now on file in this office

And *P. Hoffman* Deput. Collr. having certified that the said ~~Canal Boat~~ or Vessel has one deck and no mast and that her length is 93 feet 6 inches her breadth 17 feet 3 inches her depth 8 feet 9 inches and that she measures 131 tons 93 ninety-fifths that she is a Canal Boat has a square stern/ and plain head.

And the said *H. Miles* and *John Pease* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
