

# ENROLLEMENT.



## District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

Marcus Dimick

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and owns 3/4<sup>th</sup> parts undivided of the Brig called the Banner of Buffalo; that Charles F. Magill resides at Chicago Ill and owns 1/4<sup>th</sup> part undivided of said Brig; and that they both are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the said Brig called the Banner of Buffalo whereof ~~Charles F. Magill~~ <sup>Wm. Welch</sup> is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Conneaut State of Ohio in the year 1847, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port May 3. 1855. No. 39 - papers since owners changed

And said Certificate the said Brig or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 146 feet inches her breadth 28 feet 10 inches her depth 11 feet 1/2 inches and that she measures 431 tons 38 ninety-fifths that she is a Brig has a square stern and a scroll head.

And the said M. Dimick having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
