



ENROLLMENT.



District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek and that Lyman Cook resides at Evans Erie County N.Y. and that Israel S. Cook and David Cook reside at Hanover Chautauque County N.Y. that said persons are all

Citizen^s of the United States, and sole owner ^{each} of the ^{1/4} part undivided of the Jug Propeller called the H. N. Martin of Buffalo whereof Lyman Cook is at present Master; and as he has sworn
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1857, as appears by her Enrollment dated at this port May 27. 1857 No. 93 now surrendered having owners.

her length is 72 feet inches

and that she measures 84 tons 34 ninety-fifths
that she is a Jug Propeller has a round stern
