District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northernmost, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

George R. Kibbe
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, and is the managing owner of the Schooner called the Chief Justice Marshall of Buffalo; that Edwin S. Shaw resides at the same place; that they both are

Citizen^s of the United States, and sole owners ^{each} of the ^{1/2} part undivided of the said Schooner called the Chief Justice Marshall of Buffalo whereof G. Van Norman is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cape Vincent State of New York in the year 1843, as appears by her last Enrollment at this port the 23^d June 1857 No. 103

her length is 104 feet 6 inches
her breadth 21 feet 6 inches
her depth 8 feet 9 inches
and that she measures 181 tons 64 ninety-fifths
that she is a Schooner has a square stern head.
