

ENROLLMENT.



District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo New York in the year 1857, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port September 25. 1857 No 155 now surrendered having changed owners

And said Certificate having certified that the said *Sug Propeller* or Vessel has one deck and no mast and that
her length is 51 feet 6 inches
her breadth 13 feet 6 inches
her depth 6 feet 6 inches
and that she measures 39 tons 79 ninety-fifths
that she is a *Sug Propeller* has a round stern and no figure head.

And the said *James L. Baggart* and *John W. Johnson* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Sug Propeller* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
