In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831 and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

William H. Cobb  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and owns  $\frac{8}{10}$  parts undivided of the Barque Mary Stockton of Buffalo and that Andrew Anderson resides at the same place and owns  $\frac{2}{10}$  parts undivided of said Barque, and that they both are

Citizens of the United States, and sole owners of the said Barque called the Mary Stockton of Buffalo whereof J. H. Chute is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Manito State of Michigan in the year 1853, as appears by the Certificate her last Enrollment dated at this Port May 14. 1857 No. 75. now surrendered having changed owners

And said Certificate having certified that the said Barque or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 139 feet 8 inches her breadth 28 feet 10 inches her depth 9 feet 3 inches and that she measures 349 tons 70 ninety-fifths that she is a Barque has a square stern No gallery and No figure head.

And the said William H. Cobb and Andrew Anderson having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Barque has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
