

ENROLLMENT.



District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

William Dixon
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo Dist of Buffalo Creek and that Robert Montgomery resides at the same place and they both are

Citizen^s of the United States, and sole owner^s of the Propeller Hunter
of Buffalo whereof said Dixon is at present Master; and as he has sworn
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo in the year 1854, as appears by the Certificate of Jacob W. Banta Shipwright her builder on file in this office

And Wm Wiberl Surveyor appointed to measure said vessel having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has one deck and one mast and that her length is 192 feet 8 inches her breadth 30 feet 6 inches her depth 11 feet 11 inches and that she measures 667 tons 7 ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller and plain stern head.

And the said William Dixon and plain having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
