

ENROLLMENT.

District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo Dist. of Buffalo Creek, and is the President of the Western Transportation Company, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of New York, located at Tonawanda in said Dist. and that said Company is the

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Canal Boat called the A. J. Spencer of Buffalo whereof said Sterburg is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo New York in the year 1853, as appears by the Certificate of C. A. Vanduyke Shipwright her builder on file in the office

And A. W. Agnew Surveyor of the District Port of New Brunswick And having surveyed said Canal boat and having certified that the said Canal Boat or Vessel has one deck and no mast and that her length is 80 feet 0 inches her breadth 14 feet 4 inches her depth 5 feet 6 inches and that she measures 71 tons 11 ninety-fifths that she is a Canal Boat has a square stern and no figure head.

And the said P. L. Sterburg Master of the said Canal Boat having agreed to the description and admittance above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
