District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

Lamson Enos

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and is the Owner of one half part undivided of the Bark Badger State, and Charles A. Hulse resides at Melanck State and owns the remaining one half part undivided of said Bark and that they are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Bark Badger State of Melanck whereof William S. Cross is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Melanck State of Melanck in the year 1853, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at Melanck 23rd April 1855 at 16 now undivided having changed Owners

And the said Certificate having certified that the said Bark or Vessel has one deck and three masts and that her length is 157 feet 6 inches her breadth 28 feet 4 inches her depth 12 feet 4 inches and that she measures 491 tons - 6 - ninety-fifths that she is a Bark rigged has a square stern and no gallery and no figure head. And the said Lamson Enos having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Bark has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
