In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

Charles J. Redwell
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N.Y. and Andrew S. Mason resides at the same place and are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the One undivided half part each of the Steamboat "City of Cleveland" of Buffalo whereof Charles J. Redwell is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1857, as appears by the Certificate of his former Enrollment dated at the City of Buffalo on the 9th day May A.D. 1857 Number 64

And said Certificate having certified that the said Steamboat or Vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 227 feet 9 inches her breadth 13ft 5 inches her depth 11 feet 9 inches and that she measures Seven hundred & eighty eight tons 15- ninety-fifths that she is a Steamboat has a square stern and a screw head.

And the said Charles J. Redwell having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
