# ENROLLMENT.



## District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

John G. Gibson of Buffalo N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and is the owner of two ninths part undivided of the Schoon Jenny Lind and John A. Myers and George J. C. Hohbert of the same place own each two ninths part undivided of said Schoon, and Bradford Clark of the same place owns the remaining three ninths part of said Schoon and that they all of them are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schoon Jenny Lind whereof George Radcliff is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland State of Ohio in the year 1848, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port May 10th 1858 now surrendered having changed owners

And said Certificate the said Schoon or Vessel has One deck and two masts 3 and that her length is 88 feet 3 inches her breadth 20 feet 8 inches her depth 8 feet 9 inches and that she measures 144 tons 67 ninety-fifths that she is a Schoon has a Squam stern and a Scull head.

And the said John G. Gibson agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schoon has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
