In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. in the District of Buffalo Creek and owns two thirds part undivided of the Schooner Hurricane of Buffalo; and that Morris Hazard resides at said Buffalo and owns the remaining one third part undivided of said Schooner and that they both are

Citizen^s of the United States, and sole owner^s of the

Schooner Hurricane of Buffalo
whereof *A. P. B. Scollay*

is at present Master; and as he has sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1854, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port June 5th 1855, No 129 now surrendered having changed owners,

the said Schooner or Vessel has *One* deck and *two* masts and that having certified that her length is *125* feet *3* inches her breadth *26* feet *2* inches her depth *11* feet *—* inches and that she measures *381* tons *— 87 —* ninety-fifths that she is a *Schooner* has a *Square* stern and a *Scroll* head.

And the said *Elijah St. John Bemis* and *a Scollay* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
