In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 13th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at *at Buffalo New York in the District of Buffalo Creek* and is the managing owner of the Schooner *American* of Buffalo and owns one half part undivided of said Schooner, and *Morris Hazard* resides at said Buffalo, one half part undivided of said Schooner and that they are both,

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner *American* of Buffalo whereof *A. P. B. Colley* is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Buffalo New York* State of in the year 1854, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port April 19, 1858 No 22, now surrendered having changed Owners,

And said Certificate the said Schooner or Vessel has her length is 125 feet 3 inches her breadth 7 1/2 feet 2 inches her depth 11 feet inches and that she measures 331 tons 87/100 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a Square stern and a Scull head.

And the said *Elijah J. John Bemis* and *John Bemis* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
