In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cincinnati Ohio in the year 1856, as appears by the certificate of his last Enrollment dated at this Port July 22<sup>d</sup> 1856 No-168 - now surrounded having changed Owners.

And said Certificate the said Brig or Vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 149 <sup>2</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet inches her breadth 35 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet inches her depth 11 <sup>5</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet inches and that she measures Five hundred & forty five (545) tons - 84 - ninety-fifths that she is a Brig has a Square stern and a Plum head.

And the said Augustus L Taylor and Daniel Rogers having agreed to the description and admeasurement, above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
