Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo in the year 1855, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port May 16th 1856 No 97 - Mr Saunders having changed Owners,

And said Certificate the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 131 feet 8 inches her breadth 28 feet 4 inches her depth 11 feet 1 inch and that she measures Three hundred twenty nine tons and three ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a Square stern and a Stoll head.

And the said H M Mixer agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
