In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

Robert W Scanlin

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek N. Y. and is the owner of three fourths part undivided of the Propeller called the Globe of Buffalo; and that Amos Pratt resides at suit Buffalo and is the owner of the remaining one fourth part undivided of said Propeller and they both are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the Propeller called the Globe of Buffalo whereof Amos Pratt is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Trenton State of Michigan in the year 1848, as appears by the Certificate of his last Enrollment dated at this Port June 20, 1856 No 157 now sunken and having changed owners

And said certificate the said Propeller or Vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 257 feet inches her breadth 34 feet 10 inches her depth 14 feet 6 inches

and that she measures Twelve hundred twenty three (1223) tons - 26 - ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has no Gallies stern head.

And the said Robert W Scanlin and no scroll head. having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
