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In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

of Buffalo whereof Gerald Mouldin is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Fairport Ohio in the year 1854, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port September 16th 1857 No 147 now surrendered having changed owners

And said Certificate the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 118 feet 11 1/2 inches her breadth 25 feet 5 inches her depth 9 feet 1 inch and that she measures Two hundred fifty two (252) tons ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a Square stern and a figure head.

And the said Lucius M Pratt having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
