In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

Pardon C Sherman

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek and is the Owner of one half part undivided of the Schooner San Jacinto of Buffalo; and that Elizabeth Sherman resides at said Buffalo and owns one half part undivided of said Schooner and that they both are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner San Jacinto of Buffalo whereof Henry Grant is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1856, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port May 12, 1856 No 83 now Immended having changed Owners

And said Certificate the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 130 feet inches her breadth 28 feet 2 inches her depth 11 feet 2 inches and that she measures Three hundred Twenty four (324) tons 113 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a Square stern and a figure head.

And the said Pardon C Sherman having certified that agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
