Mc Standart of Buffalo whereof the said Paul Brown is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cullid Ohio in the year 1854, as appears by the Certificate of his last Enrollment dated at this Port April 25th 1856 No 54 Now Summured having changed Owners

And said Certificate having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 45 feet 3 7/8 inches her breadth 29 feet 7/4 inches her depth 12 feet 7 inches and that she measures Four hundred eighty (480) tons 47 ninety-fifths that she is a Brig has a square stern and a Scroll head.

And the said Paul Brown having agreed to the description and admeasurements also specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
