In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better securing of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1850, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

David Dell

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in the district of Buffalo Creek N.Y. and is a,

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Sloop Propeller D. P. Edwards of Buffalo whereof David Dell is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milan Ohio in the year 1853, as appears by his former Enrollment dated at this Port

May 25 1855, numbered 78 recorded in this office, the Certificate whereof has been lost, as appears by the affidavit of Michael S. Donovan his former owner, on file in this office, and the said vessel having been changed into a Sloop Propeller, and Bartholomew Logan Special Agent having certified to such change of denomination and having certified that

the said Sloop Propeller or Vessel has One deck and no mast and that

her length is 49 feet inches

her breadth 7 1/2 feet 10 inches

her depth 4 feet inches

and that she measures thirty tons 83 ninety-fifths

that she is a Sloop Propeller and has a square stern

and no figure head.

And the said David Dell having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Sloop Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
