In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek, New York and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Barque Grace Greenwood of Buffalo whereof Charles Simmons is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Oswego State of New York in the year 1853, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port 21st May 1856 we do now summand having changed owners

And said Certificate the said Barque or Vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 137 feet 6 inches her breadth 25 feet 6 inches her depth 11 feet 6 inches and that she measures Three hundred Twenty seven (327) tons 42 ninety-fifths that she is a Barque has a Square stern and No head.

And the said Andrew Anderson and No having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Barque has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
