In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers and board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek and owns one half part undivided of the Schooner "Sea Gull" of Buffalo and that Abel J. Wood of the City of Buffalo owns the other one half part undivided of said Schooner and that they are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the Schooner called the "Sea Gull" whereof James Bradley

is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milan in the year 1845, as appears by the Certificate of his former Enrollment dated at the port of Progreso Sal, August 23, 1856 Number 17 now run under having changed owners

And said Certificate the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 82 feet inches her breadth 19 feet 10 inches her depth 7 feet 10 inches and that she measures One hundred fourteen tons 58 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern head. and Scull having

And the said James Bradley agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
