In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 17th July, 1850, and the Act of August 30th 1850, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek N.Y. and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner "Mary Jane" of Buffalo whereof said Berman is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo, N.Y. in the year 1858, as appears by the certificate of Philip Berman Shipwright her builder on file in this Office

And John H. Bidwell surveyor appointed to Measur said vessel, having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 42 feet 3 inches her breadth 13 feet 8 inches her depth 5 feet inches and that she measures Twenty Four (24) tons 45/95 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a Square stern head. And the said Philip Berman and no figure having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
