In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

Blanchett is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo New York in the year 1857, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port November 7th 1857 numbered 465. now surrendered, having changed owners

And said Certificate of Enrollment the said Propeller or Vessel has One deck and no mast and that her length is 84 feet inches her breadth 14 feet 11 inches her depth 7 feet 5 inches and that she measures Ninety Four (94) tons 59 ninety-fifths that she is a Sloop Propeller has a round stern head. and a scroll head.

And the said Edward C. Blanchett having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y. agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Sloop Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
