In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in said District of Buffalo Creek, and is Secretary of the American Transportation Company, a Corporation organized under the laws of the State of New York, and that said Corporation is

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Sloop Propeller called the President of Buffalo whereof James C. Evans is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo, New York in the year 1855, as appears by the Certificate of J. H. Moller her builder on file in this office State of New York

And B. Logan Special Surveyor appointed to measure said Propeller having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has one deck and no mast and that her length is 74 feet - 6 - inches her breadth 14 feet - 11 - inches her depth 7 feet - 7 - inches and that she measures Eighty six (86) tons - 84 - ninety-fifths that she is a Sloop Propeller has a round stern and no figure head.

And the said James C. Evans having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Sloop Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
