In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1858, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig called the *Cecaw* of Tonawanda whereof Robert Murphy is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Three Mile Bay State of New York in the year 1848, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at the Port of Oswego, May 31st 1858. numbered 19 now surrendered having changed owners

And the said Certificate having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has One deck and Two masts, and that her length is 119 feet inches her breadth 24 feet 3 inches her depth 9 feet 8 inches and that she measures Two hundred fifty seven tons 81 ninety-fifths that she is a Brig has a square stern and a scoll. figure head.

And the said William Emerson having agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
