In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 2d 1850, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850

Having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek N.Y. and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the *Trig Propeller* 'Buffalo' whereof the said Oldman is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo, State of New York in the year 1858, as appears by the Certificate of William Reed Shipwright her builder on file in this Office

And B. Logan surveyor appointed to measure said *Trig Propeller* having certified that the said *Trig Propeller* or Vessel has One deck and NO masts and that her length is 48 feet 4 inches her breadth 13 feet 2 inches her depth 5 feet 8 inches and that she measures Thirty One (31) tons 12 ninety-fifths that she is a *Trig Propeller* has a round stern and no head.

And the said William Oldman and no having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Trig Propeller* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
