In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

R. R. Johnson

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek, New York and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig Venice of Buffalo whereof J. P. Dillon

is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Rochester New York in the year 1847, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port March 10th 1857 numbered "17" now surrendered having changed Owners.

And said Certificate the said Brig or Vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 116 feet — 5 — inches having certified that her breadth 35 feet — 3 — inches and that she measures Two hundred and fifty three tons — 43 — ninety-fifths that she is a Brig has a square stern and a scull head.

And the said R. R. Johnson and a scull head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig — has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
