In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

Lynnman Cook

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Evans in the District of Buffalo Creek N.Y. that Israel T. Cook resides at Canover in the County of Chautauque and State of New York and that they each own 1/4 part undivided of the Sloop Propeller "W.C. Martin" of Buffalo, and David Cook of said Canover, the other 1/4 part of the said Sloop Propeller "W.C. Martin" and that they are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the said Sloop Propeller "W.C. Martin" of Buffalo whereof D. Cook is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo New York in the year 1857, as appears by her former Enrollment dated at this Port September 15th 1857 numbered 145. now surrendered having changed owners

And said Certificate of Enrollment the said Sloop Propeller or Vessel has One deck and no mast and that her length is 72 feet inches her breadth 16 feet inches her depth 8 feet 6 inches and that she measures Eighty nine tons 30 ninety-fifths that she is a Sloop Propeller has a round stern and a plain head.

And the said Lynnman Cook agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
