In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lines of Passengers and board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the Schooner called the "Ariel" of Providence whereof Dexter Corwin is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Sacketts Harbor State of New York in the year 1847, as appears by the Certificate of his last Enrollment dated at the Port of Chicago March 15th 1858, now surrendered ^{and transferred to me} having changed owners and District

And said Certificate having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is - 118 - feet - inches her breadth - 24 - feet - inches her depth - 9 - feet - 6 - inches and that she measures Two hundred and fifty four (254) tons - 1 - ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a Square stern head.

And the said William P. Weedon and Royal C. Taft having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
