In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850. And an Act to authorize the Enrollment Registry and License of certain Steamboats or Vessels owned by the Buffalo and Lake Huron Rail Road Company approved March 1st 1857. James Mackurdy having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he is President of the Buffalo and Lake Huron Rail Road Company, a corporation doing business under and by virtue of the Laws of the State of New York, and that said Company is the true

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Steamboat Intermational of Buffalo whereof A. H. Squire is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo New York in the year 1857, as appears by the Certificate of his last Enrollment dated at this Port December 3rd 1857 numbered "168" now surrendered having changed owners

And said Certificate the said Steamboat or Vessel has One deck and no mast and that her length is 226 feet — inches her breadth 40 feet 8 inches her depth 13 feet — inches and that she measures One hundred twenty one tons — 84 — ninety-fifths that she is a Steamboat has a round stern and Main head.

And the said James Mackurdy agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steamboat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
