In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th 1852; amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

of New York whereof L. P. Dibble  
is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Irving  
New York in the year 1854, as appears by the certificate of her last  
Enrollment dated at the Port of Chicago, June 17, 1858  
numbered 41. now suspended. Having changed owners and  
districts

And said certificate  
the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and two masts and that  
her length is 96 feet inches  
her breadth 22 feet 11 1/2 inches  
her depth 8 feet 4 inches  
and that she measures One hundred sixty five tons 10 ninety-fifths  
that she is a Schooner has a square stern  
and no figure head.

agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with  
the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
