In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at New York and jointly with Jonathan A. Ponce, under the firm name of Dibble and Ponce residing and doing business in the City of New York, own the whole of the "Brig Sutton" and that they are

is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Chicago in the year 1848, as appears by Record of his last Enrollment dated at this port August 26th 1858, numbered 26 - the Certificate of which has been lost as appears by the affidavit of L. P. Dibble one of his owners on file in this office

And said Enrollment the said Brig or Vessel has *OW* deck and *Two* masts and that her length is *127* feet *00* inches her breadth *24* feet *00* inches her depth *4* feet *4 3/8* inches and that she measures *Two Hundred Sixty seven* tons *ninety-fifths* that she is a *Brig* has a *no* galley *stern* and a *Billet* *head*

And the said *L. P. Dibble* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.*
