In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller *May Flower* of Buffalo whereof *S. W. Langley* is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1852, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port March 11th 1850. numbered 17 now surrendered by reason of a change of Officers of said Company

And said Certificate the said Propeller or Vessel has *one* deck and *two* masts *and* that her length is *185* feet *—* inches her breadth *28* feet *—* inches her depth *12* feet *7* inches and that she measures *Six hundred twenty three* tons *— 77* ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has a *—* stern/ head.

And the said *Pirds A. Root* and *—* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
