## District of Buffalo Creek, } PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

*Andrew Anderson*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek N.Y. and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the *Barque Grace Greenwood* of Buffalo whereof *Andrew Anderson* is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Oswego* State of *New York* in the year 1853, as appears by the certificate of his last Enrollment dated at this Port April 11th 1859 numbered "9" now surrendered having changed owners

And said certificate having certified that the said *Barque* or Vessel has *One* deck and *three* masts and that her length is *43* feet *6* inches her breadth *25* feet *6* inches her depth *11* feet *6* inches and that she measures *Three hundred twenty seven* tons *1/2* ninety-fifths that she is a *Barque* has a *square* stern and no head.

And the said *Andrew Anderson* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Barque* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
