In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

James R. Smith

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek, N.Y., and jointly with Harrison B. Nisner under the firm name of Moore and Smith residing and doing business in the city of Buffalo own the whole of the Barque "Mary Stockton" of Buffalo, and they are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the said Barque Mary Stockton of Buffalo whereof William Walker is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Maritow State of Michigan in the year 1853, as appears by the former Enrollment recorded in this office October 2<sup>d</sup> 1857 numbered 759 the certificate of which was surrendered at this port March 2<sup>d</sup> 1859 having changed owners.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Barque or Vessel has Deck and three masts and that her length is 39 feet 8 inches her breadth 28 feet 10 inches her depth 9 feet 5 inches and that she measures One hundred forty nine tons 70 ninety-fifths that she is a Barque has a square stern and no figure head.

And the said James R. Smith and no figure head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
