And said Certificate the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 82 feet 6 inches her breadth 19 feet 0 inches her depth 6 feet 9 inches and that she measures Eighty five tons and that she is a Schooner has a no Gally stern and no figure head.

And the said Charles Williams having agreed to the description and advertisement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
