O. Brown her owner on file in this Office, having changed Owners

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 140 feet 2 inches her breadth 26 feet 2 inches her depth 11 feet 5 inches and that she measures Three hundred & thirty One tons & 42/95 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a Square stern head and plain

And the said W. O. Brown and plain having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
