In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at ^{the 3d District of the City of Buffalo} ^{18th February 1853} and is a citizen of the United States and that the Schooner "Orion" is owned by ^{Wm. Winslow} of Chicago, Illinois, as appeared in her last Enrollment and license dated at the Port of Chicago, May 5th 1858 respectively, and that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the said Schooner "Orion" of Chicago whereof ^{he is} Master; and as he has sworn is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at ^{Neilan} Ohio in the year 1857, as appears by the certificate of Enrollment above referred to ^{Amended 1852} now surrendered, her license having expired.
