In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Rochester New York State of New York in the year 1847, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port the 20th day of October 1858 and numbered 110 - now surrounded having changed Owners

And said Certificate the said Brig or Vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 116 feet 5 inches her breadth 25 feet 3 inches her depth 9 feet 5 inches and that she measures Two hundred & fifty three tons & 43 - ninety-fifths that she is a Brig has a Square stern and a scroll head.

And the said Rufus R Johnson having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
