In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

in the District of Buffalo Creek and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller *Queen of the Lakes* whereof *John P. Davis* is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Black River* State of *Ohio* in the year 1853, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port March 20th 1855 numbered 7- now surrendered having changed Owners

And said Certificate the said Propeller or Vessel has *two* deck and *one* mast and that her length is *185* feet *10* inches her breadth *26* feet *11* inches her depth *12* feet *2* inches and that she measures *Five hundred & sixty three (563)* tons — *53* — ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has a round stern head and no figure

And the said *Edward J. Evans* and *no figure* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
